

WOMEN'S AUSTRALIAN TITLE STATUS 20 OCTOBER 2019

The Status of the ANBF Women's Australian title is shown below for those divisions with a champion or a scheduled championship contest.

In all other divisions the Australian Women's title is vacant.

Middleweight

Champion: Tayla Harris

Won title: 18th October 2019 Mandatory date 18th April 2020

Super Welterweight

Champion: Title Vacant

Title contest: Tayla Harris vs Janay Harding

Date/location 22nd November, Melbourne Pavilion

Promotor: Brian Amatruda

(If Tayla Harris wins she will be both the Australian Women's Middleweight and Super Welterweight champion. Under ANBF Rule 82, she will have 7 days from 22nd November 2019 to decide which of these Australian titles to relinquish.)

Welterweight

Champion: Kylie Hutt

Won title: 16th March 2018

Currently no challengers for this title have been communicated to the ANBF.

Lightweight

Champion: Rachael Loder Won title: 15th June 2019

Currently no challengers for this title have been communicated to the ANBF.

Featherweight

Champion: Bianca Elmir Won Title: 5 April 2019

Currently no challengers for this title have been communicated to the ANBF.

Acceptable matches in all vacant weight divisions may be sanctioned without referring to the industry.

Note: As per the ANBF rules, the ANBF Directors shall determine what are acceptable matches for the purpose of sanctioning Australian title contests.
